- ✓ Assists the Eskasoni Mental Health Services and ACCESS-OM Teams in developing and implementing youth-oriented programs and activities, including sport/recreation/cultural/traditional.
- ✓ Develops and implements intervention plans within program guidelines. Provides referrals, support, guidance and problem solving to clients and their families/carers to address issues related to client/family functioning.
- ✓ Provides parenting skill building, emotional support and feedback to clients/families.
- ✓ The Behavior Interventionist helps coordinate Functional Assessments of Behavior and Behavior Intervention Plans that address behaviors and provide a means to help the youth and family succeed and address challenges.

Successful Candidates will have:

- ✓ A minimum of a Diploma and/or Bachelor's degree in Behavior Intervention/Child Studies or a relevant related human / social service field and be Registered, or eligible to be registered, with a governing and licensing Board.
- ✓ At least (1) one year relevant experience in the delivery of a full range of behavioral interventions.
- ✓ Take charge attitude with the ability to problem solve;
- ✓ Ability to work effectively in a fast paced growing community health/mental health care facility;
- ✓ Ability to speak Mi'kmaq considered an asset.
