Key Responsibilities Include:

- ✓ Assists the Eskasoni Community Health Teams (Primary Care, Community Health, Maternal Child Health and Mental Health) in developing and implementing a comprehensive diabetes management perinatal program for clients;
- ✓ The Diabetes Nurse Educator is responsible for, and provides, direct clinical services, including screening, education, assessment, intervention, supervision and consultation with clients.
- ✓ The Diabetes Nurse Educator provides individual, family and community education and counselling in diabetes prevention and management that is culturally appropriate within the Eskasoni First Nation.
- ✓ Assists in the recruitment of specialized professional services (internal and external to the community) that will ensure that the identified needs, and service gaps of the client are being met.

- ✓ BScN, from an accredited university.
- ✓ Current registration with the College of Registered Nurses of Nova Scotia.
- ✓ Certified Diabetes Educator (CDE) or willingness to obtain within 2 years.
